Concerned Okinawans have occupied several construction towers outside Henoko in Oura Bay for over a decade. The US Military tried to expand Camp Schwab with a proposed runway and helicopter pad on top of a coral reef and Okinawan Manatee (dugong) habitat. The protesters set up a permanent camp in view of the construction site, obtaining water safety training, boat licenses, and scuba certification in order to protest safely. In the fourteen years of occupation, the steel towers rusted and the towers were removed. The governments will try again but the resistance to the US occupation of Okinawa will continue.
